Preliminary Event Program

Use this Preliminary Event Program to get an idea of activities that will occur during Alumafiesta. **Note that this program will likely change before it is finalized, so you should not plan your daily activities based solely on this Preliminary schedule. Note the version # at the bottom of this page—updated versions will be posted on the Alumafiesta website periodically.**

Most morning and evening activities are held in the Event Center. That's the big white tent-building. You'll need to wear your wristband for entry.

Name badges are optional, but a good idea if you want other people to remember you!

Orientation will be held Tuesday at 2:00 pm. It's optional, but a good opportunity to get information about the activities of the week. We'll also have an open Question & Answer session about anything related to Airstreaming.

Activities and tours depart from the Meeting Point by the Event Center parking lot. It's near sites 1420-1425 on the campground map. There will also be a Meeting Point sign.

START times for off-site events are the times the leader will be departing the Lazydays Event Center parking lot. Please arrive early. If a formal tour is scheduled, the start time for the tour is generally about 30 minutes later unless noted on the schedule.

END times for all off-site events are estimates only. You can come back whenever you want. Be sure to coordinate with the people in your carpool.

Off-site lunches: Sign up and pay in the Event Center, for the optional lunches. All prices shown in this program are per-person and include tax and tip.

Note: the light lunch at Tin Town is for attendees of that tour only because it is included in the cost of admission.

There will be a complimentary wine/beer/margarita bar at Tuesday's Happy Hour, and it will be a cash bar the rest of the week.

Breakfast/dinner: All of the breakfasts and dinner are fully catered and included in your event fee. You don't need to bring anything. There will be a choice of two dinner options, one of which will be vegetarian.

Aluminum Chef: This fun cooking contest on Thursday challenges you to make a dish in your Airstream kitchen with five specific ingredients. Visit our website for the full details including a list of the ingredients you'll need *(TO BE ANNOUNCED IN DECEMBER)*. It's great fun, so we encourage you to give it a try! Three contestants will go on to the second level "Shootout" and get awards.

Gem Show: This is going on all week at various locations around Tucson. Check the Event Center "concierge table" for information about some of the closest venues.
