Pre-Event Information

## ARRIVAL/REGISTRATION

**The Tucson/Lazydays KOA is at 5151 South Country Club Road, Tucson AZ.** (If you have been here before, please note that this is a change. The former entrance on East Irvington will not work.)

Go through the gate, straight past the white Event Center tent, and pull up to the registration building. Lazydays front desk staff will check you in, and direct you to your site.

Every site is great, with full hookups, free wireless Internet, cable TV, picnic tables, and daily trash pickup.

You will get one “goody bag” per registered trailer. It will contain the final event program, name badges, wristbands (which are your admission to the Event Center and all other events), and a bunch of other stuff. Please wear the wristband and/or name badge during the entire event so we know you’re a registered attendee. The name badge is a good idea if you want people to know who you are.

If you want to book extra nights (besides the event nights), just call the campground at 520-799-3701 and tell them you are in the Alumafiesta group.

## SPECIAL EVENTS

### Off-site Tours & Activities

You will have the chance to choose optional activities when you arrive. We’ll have sign-up sheets in the Event Center. Many tours have limited capacities, so check the sign-up sheets as soon as you can after you are parked. There’s no guarantee that space will be available, so it’s best to choose as early as possible. If there’s a fee associated with the activity, you should pay when you sign up.

Many of the tours call for car-pooling. The leader of each tour will meet you at a designated area by the Event Center (look for a Meeting Point sign). Please try to arrive a few minutes early so the leader can verify the count and get everyone organized into carpools. Parking is limited at many of the sites, so carpooling is very helpful.

**Each tour departs at the time shown on the schedule;** please be on time because the leaders can’t wait.
